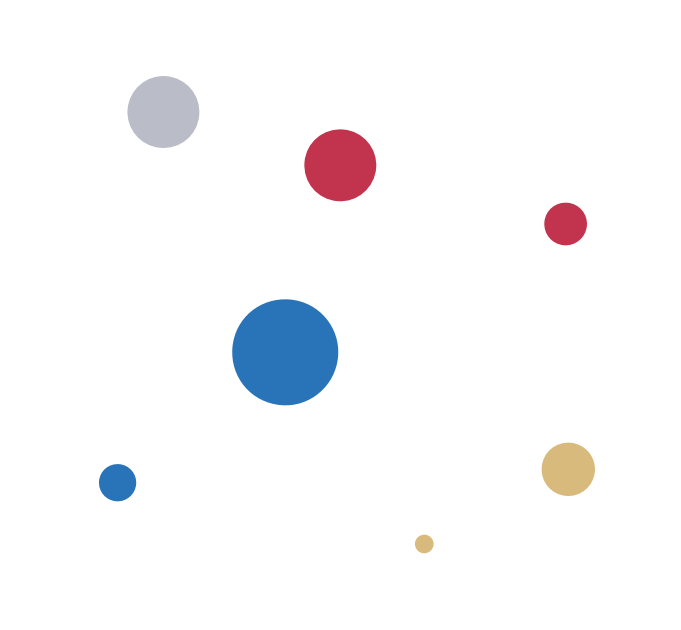

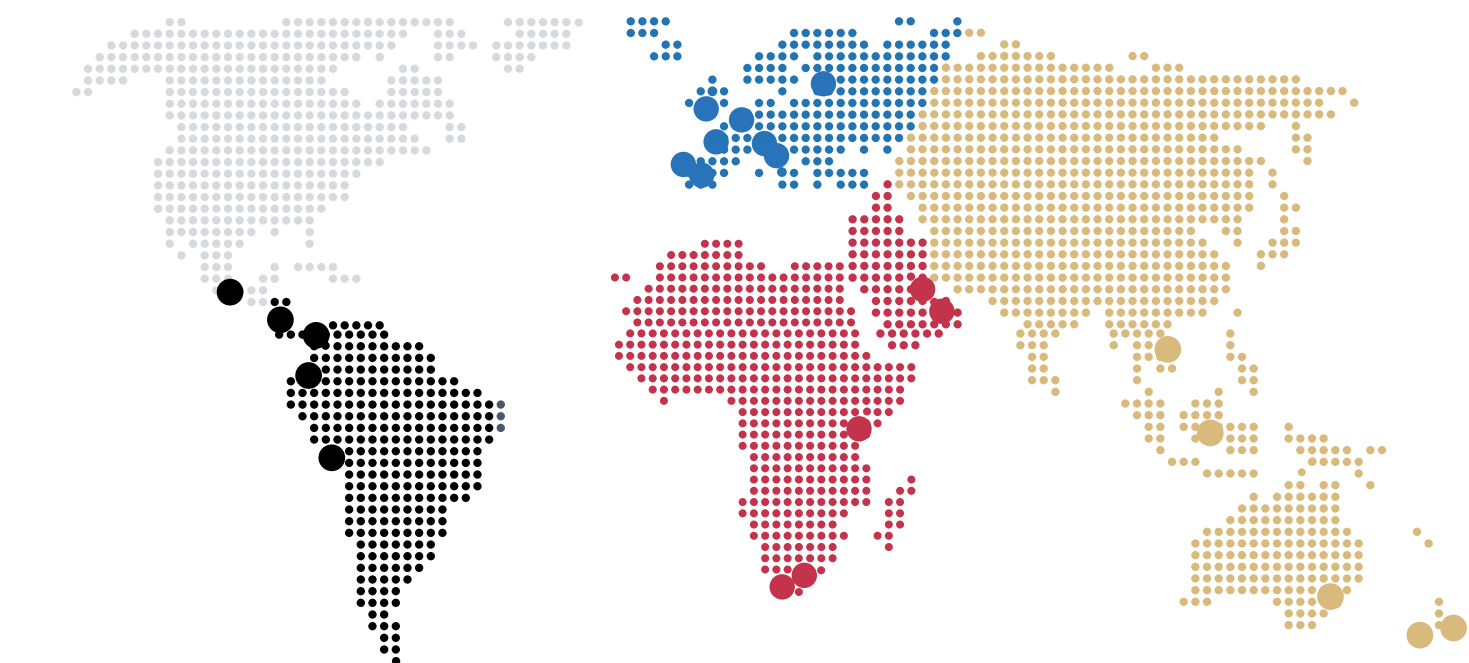

King's College Online has pioneered a new approach to online schooling, with a unique combination of live lessons combined with smaller group tutorials.

Students build lasting relationships with their fellow students and have the support of a dedicated personal tutor.



01

Live-streamed lessons delivered by passionate, expert teachers selected from the Inspired network of prestigious schools.

- Each subject has three hours of real-time lessons every week.
- These lessons provide key subject knowledge, skills, understanding and examination techniques.
- The interactive nature of the live lessons stimulates discussion and debate.
- All lessons are recorded, ensuring students never have their learning interrupted and lesson recordings can be revisited for revision.

02

Tutor-led study groups.

- Each subject has three hours of small study-group sessions every week.
- Through discussion and coaching, these sessions facilitate a deeper understanding of the lesson content and encourage students to apply this learning in practical situations.
- With a maximum of 15 students per study group, these sessions provide personalised and effective support.

03

Regular assignments to assess knowledge and the application of learning.

- A core part of the learning programme - a combination of online tests, written assignments, oral presentations and practice examinations.
- The A level programme is modular with examinations taken at the end of each unit. This means students can accrue modular results as they go and can also retake exam modules to improve grades.

What is unique about King's College Online?

King's College Online is the first online school to combine the strengths of remote learning with the tangible benefits of campus-based school experiences.



Students can enjoy the flexibility of an online learning platform, combined with the experience of life at one of over 60 of Inspired's top schools around the world, for one to two weeks each term, as part of our **Short-Stay programme**.

During these visits, live online learning will remain at the core of each student's education while they immerse themselves in a new culture, and make new friends as part of the everyday life of their host school.

King's College Online students also enjoy preferential access to Inspired's premium **Summer and Winter camps**, with access to amazing, one-of-a-kind experiences like fashion and design courses at the Inspired

school in Milan, skiing in Switzerland and football in Madrid in partnership with the Fundación Real Madrid.

Our **academic booster camps** during the school breaks offer students the opportunity to deepen their learning and complete practical activities to further enrich the course.

All students at King's College Online have the further advantage of taking a one-year International GCSE programme online and then **transferring** to any one of Inspired's schools to take their A levels or the International Baccalaureate Diploma.



Stimulating academic courses

All King's College Online students follow the Pearson Edexcel International GCSE and A level specifications.

Over 3.4 million students worldwide have already successfully studied with the Pearson curriculum. The following subjects are available for both the International GCSE and A level:

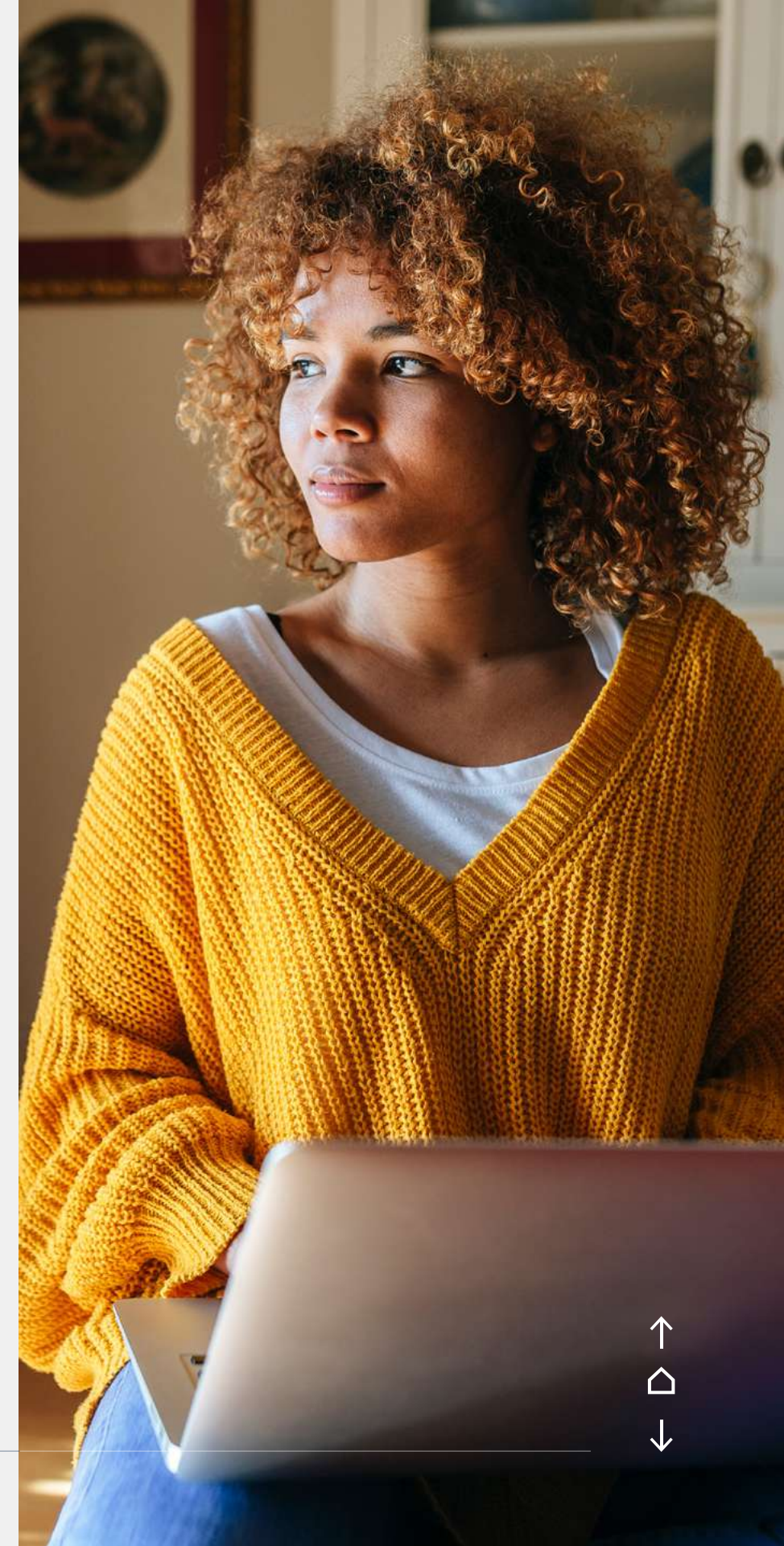

All International GCSEs courses are for one-year.

All A levels are modular 2-year courses, where examinations can be taken at the end of each unit of study, or throughout the programme of study when a student feels ready, or all together at the end of the course. This means after the first-year students will be awarded AS levels for successfully completed units, which count towards university entrance. This system also gives students the ability to retake examinations for any modules that they wish to improve their grades in. International examinations will be taken locally at approved Examination centres.

*Accounting is only available at International GCSE level for January 2021 entry.



Course fee structure

King’s College Online offers full-time International GCSE and A level courses, recommending a minimum of 5 International GCSEs and 4 A levels, in line with the British curriculum standards and university entrance requirements.

King’s College Online’s all-inclusive pricing means that one fee encompasses the full cost of completing the recommended number of subjects.

- The full-time programme of study for International GCSEs covers **5 subjects** at the cost of **€7,000**.
- The full-time programme of study for A levels covers **4 subjects** at the cost of **€7,000**.

Whilst most of our students follow a full-time curriculum, some students may wish to supplement their existing studies by enrolling for specific courses.

Individual subject places are available and are priced at:

- International GCSEs

- International A levels
€1,850 per individual subject

King's College Online is a non-selective school and ensures that every student is treated as an individual to fulfil their true potential.

A good level of spoken and written English is required to ensure students can access learning effectively, which is assessed as part of the admissions process.

Recent school reports and any relevant examination results are also reviewed, to assess current levels of attainment and aptitude for learning.

Complete the application form and pay the application fee.

Take advantage of the introductory offer with the €100 application fee waived for all students wishing to join in January 2021.

Take our English assessment.

Whilst the school is non-selective, all lessons are taught in English, so students need competency in English to ensure successful learning.

03

Submit your two last school reports.

We would also like to see any recent exam results so teachers can assess what support might be needed to maximise success at King's College Online.

Entrance requirements

With an age range of between 14 and 18 years, King's College Online is looking for students with a strong desire to learn and to succeed.

Eligible students will be expected to be entering or already in years 10/11 (Grades 9/10) for International GCSE and years 12/13 (Grades 11/12) for A levels.

English language capability is assessed through the Oxford Placement Test - with entry requirements of B1 or higher for the International GCSEs (equivalent to IELTS level 5) and B2 or higher for A levels (equivalent to IELTS level 5.5).

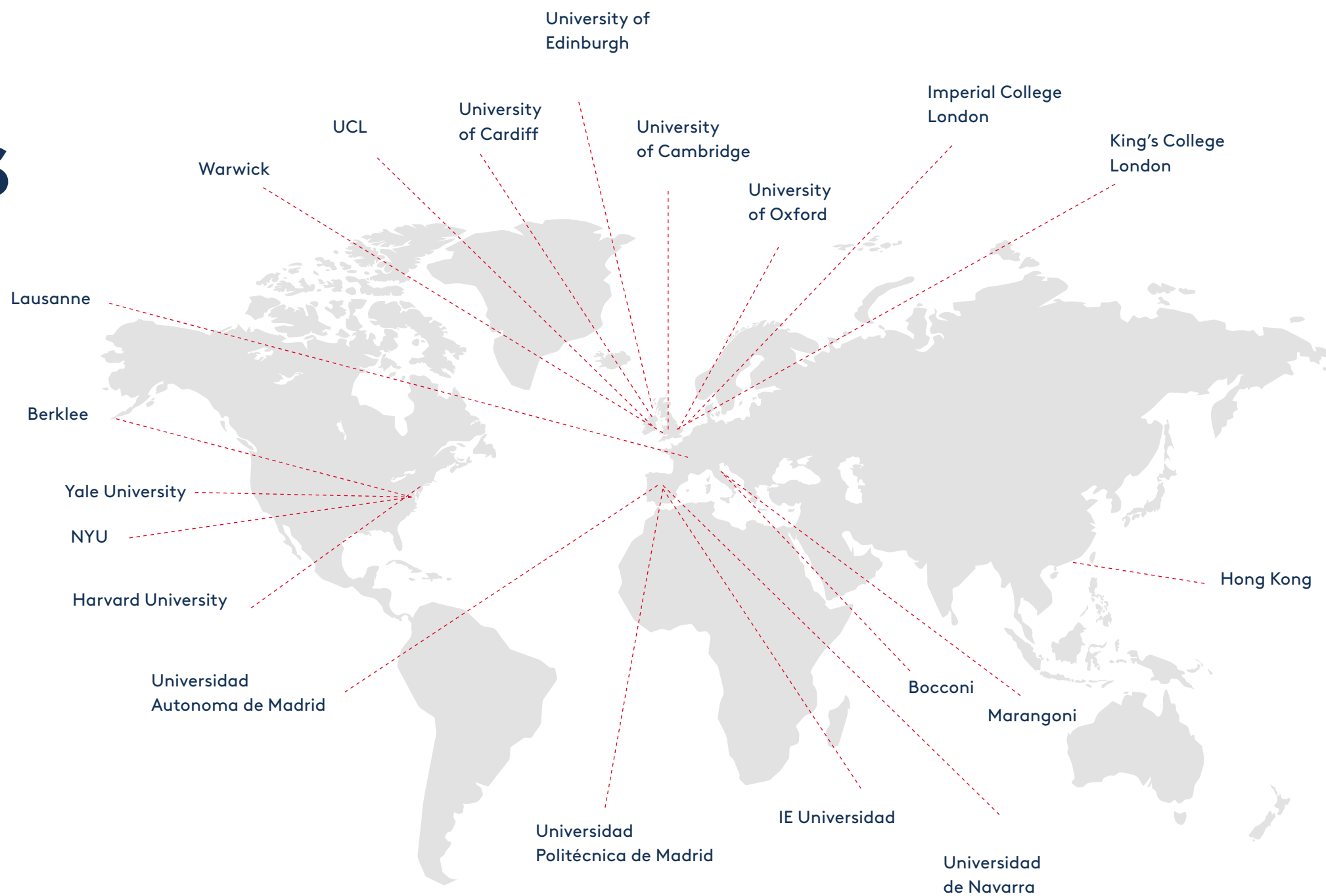
Students must be age 16+ if they are resident in New Zealand
